Dear Mr. Crohn:

- Urge Governor Cuomo to include <u>Licensed Clinical Social Work psychotherapy services</u> in the Workers' Compensation program. Sign <u>A.5299-B</u> into law.
- Workers' compensation health care is designed to help the injured <u>return to work and</u> <u>productivity as quickly as possible.</u>
- The stress, anxiety and depression which often accompanies pain and increased dependency due to injury makes <u>access to mental health services critical</u> to injured workers.
- The New York Supreme Court has determined that the scopes of practice for LCSWs and clinical psychologists (whose services are currently covered) are equivalent...this legislation merely reflects changes in the licensing laws enacted in 2002

• This bill does not add a new category of care, but expands geographically the pool of qualified providers available to treat the mental side effects of pain, helplessness and increased dependency due to injury.
